


LEAP's Drama and Musical Theatre showcases 2015

As you are aware LEAP's focus this year has been on technique and pupils are given the opportunity to perform in small showcases.

The Downley School is the venue for LEAP's individual show cases this summer.

Please note that tickets are now on sale, all you have to do is email your tickets requests or see your LEAP teacher at the end of a class and





tickets will be issued to pupils during their next LEAP class once payment is made via bank transfer, cash or cheque (cheques payable to LEAP). All tickets are priced at \pm 5, LEAP Pupils \pm 4. Please note that young children must have their own seats – we regret that <u>children under 3 years</u> <u>are not allowed.</u>

Please advise in advance if you require disabled access.

Shows consisting of more than one year group requires quality rehearsal time and planning. Therefore, it is important that pupils are given the opportunity to work together to finalise the show as they have only been working on their individual section in class time. If students are unable to attend **any** of the rehearsals, **it is crucial that you contact me as soon as possible.**






